

# Privacy Policy – Cookies

## How we use your information

This privacy notice tells you what information we collect about visitors to the Southampton East Pastoral Area website.

## Visitors to our website

When someone visits [www.ckscolasb.org.uk](http://www.ckscolasb.org.uk) we use cookies (see below) to collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns – see StatCounter below. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the site. We collect this information in a way which does not identify anyone. We do not make any attempt to find out the identities of those visiting our website. We will not associate any data gathered from this site with any personally identifying information from any source.

This information is used for system administration, tracking errors and for producing usage statistics. The logged information may be kept indefinitely and is not shared with any third party, except if required by law. Summary statistics are extracted from this data and some of these may be made publicly available, but those that are do not include information from which individuals could be identified.

We also use third parties such as Google to provide maps of our churches and KeepandShare to provide a calendar of Pastoral Area events – see below.

## Use of cookies by the PA Website

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site.

If you are concerned about privacy, you may set up your browser not to accept cookies, or you can delete them from your hard drive once you leave the section – but your browsing experience on this website may be diminished.

The table below explains the cookies we use and why.

Originator	Purpose	More information
StatCounter	These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our site. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the site. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the site, where visitors have come to the site from and the pages they visited. KeepandShare	These cookies are used to collect usage data and non-personal information about visitors to the KeepandShare website.
